In February, HOPE³ Ministries celebrated five years of being an incorporated ministry! Some of you have heard this story a time or two, but it bears repeating: The idea of HOPE³ was conceived during Deb Leeper's participation in the Walk to Emmaus program. On April 30, 2009, God called her, alongside her husband, Richard, to accomplish a very special project for Him. The project has come to be known as the HOPE³ Weekend.

As it turns out, HOPE³ Ministries grew far bigger than just the weekend program. In fact, the Leepers and an early group of advisors knew that the foundation of a nonprofit corporation would be required to carry out the mission of this special call.

The necessary Articles of Incorporation were submitted to the State Corporation Commission of the Commonwealth of Virginia on January 28, 2012 and, after three weeks of anxious waiting, on February 17, 2012, HOPE³ Ministries received the Certificate of Incorporation from the Commission. It was official. A board of directors was formed, a website was created and the curriculum team for the Weekend started meeting. What an achievement!

One year later, on March 13, 2013, HOPE³ Ministries received notification of its 501(c)(3) status by the Internal Revenue Service, allowing the ministry to collect tax-deductible donations from its friends and supporters. In May 2014, the first HOPE³ Weekend was held. In addition, a Bible Study group started meeting, and monthly Family Fun gatherings began in August 2012.

We rejoice in the ups and downs of the last five years. What a wonderful journey it has been. Dozens of servants have contributed to the vision and mission of this ministry, and hundreds of folks from all walks of life have been impacted by its programming.

We at HOPE³ Ministries are thankful to God for His faithful guidance and direction along the way, and we are looking forward to what the future holds. Join us in celebrating this special anniversary and the achievements of the last five years. We know the best is yet to come!

In order for this to happen, HOPE³ provides sponsor training that explains the Weekend and post-Weekend obligations. Sponsors are provided resource materials to assist them in working with their seed
